

Academic Integrity Policy

1. DLI is responsible for ensuring academic integrity standards for the joint campus.
2. All staff and students at DLI undertake to act with honesty, trust, fairness, respect and responsibility in their activities and to promote a culture of ethical academic and scholarly conduct.
3. Academic integrity is an integral part of the scholarly process. It ensures DLI students who graduate from Deakin University and Lancaster University have clearly demonstrated the learning outcomes associated with their course and have developed a professional identity that has integrity at its core.
4. DLI will provide students with guidance on what constitutes a breach of academic integrity and adopt an educative approach in developing good practices in maintaining academic integrity.
5. DLI will take action to mitigate foreseeable risks to academic integrity and to prevent recurrences of breaches.
6. Breaches of academic integrity will be managed by DLI in accordance with both Deakin University and Lancaster University policies.
