Academic Progress Policy

- 1. Academic progress provisions monitor student progression through their course of study to ensure satisfactory completion of course requirements.
- 2. Each award course at DLI will have academic progress requirements detailed and approved through the course approval process.
- 3. All academic progress requirements will be published on the DLI website, and any changes after publication advised to affected students in writing as soon as possible.
- 4. DLI will monitor students' academic progress and provide services, including support, to help students meet academic progress requirements.
- 5. Examining bodies will determine whether a student has successfully met the progression requirements for a course, giving full countenance to exceptional circumstances and reassessment opportunities.
- 6. DLI will provide services, including support, to help students meet academic progress standards.
- 7. Unsatisfactory academic progress will be managed by DLI in accordance with both Deakin University and Lancaster University policies.

The Joint Procedures Manual will draw upon the Lancaster University <u>Undergraduate Assessment</u> <u>Regulations</u> (Section 5 – Degree Progression) and the Deakin University <u>Academic Progress Policy</u>.
