Student Code of Conduct

- 1. DLI will maintain procedures to support responsible and ethical behaviour and conduct expected of DLI students as part of contributing to a thriving, progressive, respectful and inclusive community.
- 2. DLI students will be expected to pursue their academic studies in a diligent, ethical and responsible manner, taking the initiative to develop the skills needed to become a successful and independent learner.
- Students will provide information to DLI at the earliest opportunity if there is an issue that
 may impact upon their studies and seek advice where appropriate from relevant support
 services.
- 4. DLI students are expected to participate in opportunities to provide feedback on aspects of their programme and to contribute to the wider discussions about academic life at DLI.
- 5. DLI Students will:
 - (a) undertake their academic work with integrity and honesty;
 - (b) work cooperatively and collaboratively with other students, staff, associates and DLI partners;
 - educate themselves on, and comply with all relevant policies and with any codes of conduct and practice that apply at the course or professional level, including those of external partner organisations;
 - (d) communicate with courtesy and consideration in person and online (including via email and social media);
 - (e) responsibly exercise their rights to freedom of speech and academic freedom, and respect others' rights to their own opinions and beliefs;
 - (f) uphold the health, safety, wellbeing and privacy of others in the University community;
 - (g) use DLI property, facilities and resources responsibly, in accordance with relevant policies and considering others' needs;
 - (h) follow reasonable directions from DLI staff;
 - (i) provide accurate personal details to DLI, keep those details up to date, and read and respond to official DLI communications (including via DLI email) in a timely manner.
- 6. DLI encourages students and staff to raise any concerns related to the Student Code of Conduct by contacting the DLI Chief Operating Officer.
- 7. Alleged or actual breaches of the Student Code of Conduct are taken seriously by DLI and may be dealt with by the relevant policy set out in the section on Misconduct.

The Joint Procedures Manual will draw upon the <u>Deakin University Student Code of Conduct</u> and Lancaster University <u>Student Charter</u>.
